

LIMPO SILOISO IN NORWAY

Response Network programs do not work in isolation but they are all inter related. Every year the Sports program sends and receives youths on an exchange program called Youth Sport exchange program with a mission of cultural exchange. Last year Response Network conducted interviews to select two candidates that will either be sent to Norway or east Africa. Upon hearing the announcement, our very own Kubala girls (girls under the sponsorship program) did not sit back as they looked at the qualifications needed and they possessed them all, so they took up the challenge and applied. 3 girls that completed their secondary school education applied and were among the 15 shortlisted candidates for interviews, out of the 15 only two were picked. Limpo Siloiso, 19, a Kubala girl was picked.



Limpo is among the first 200 girls to be supported by Academic Work in 2009 when she was in her 4th grade at Dambwa Secondary School and she worked hard and excelled up to her 12th grade at David Livingstone Secondary School. Limpo's achievement has awakened all the girls to actively participate in sports and implement all that they are taught. Limpo is in Norway for a period of 10 months (September 2018-June 2019)
